

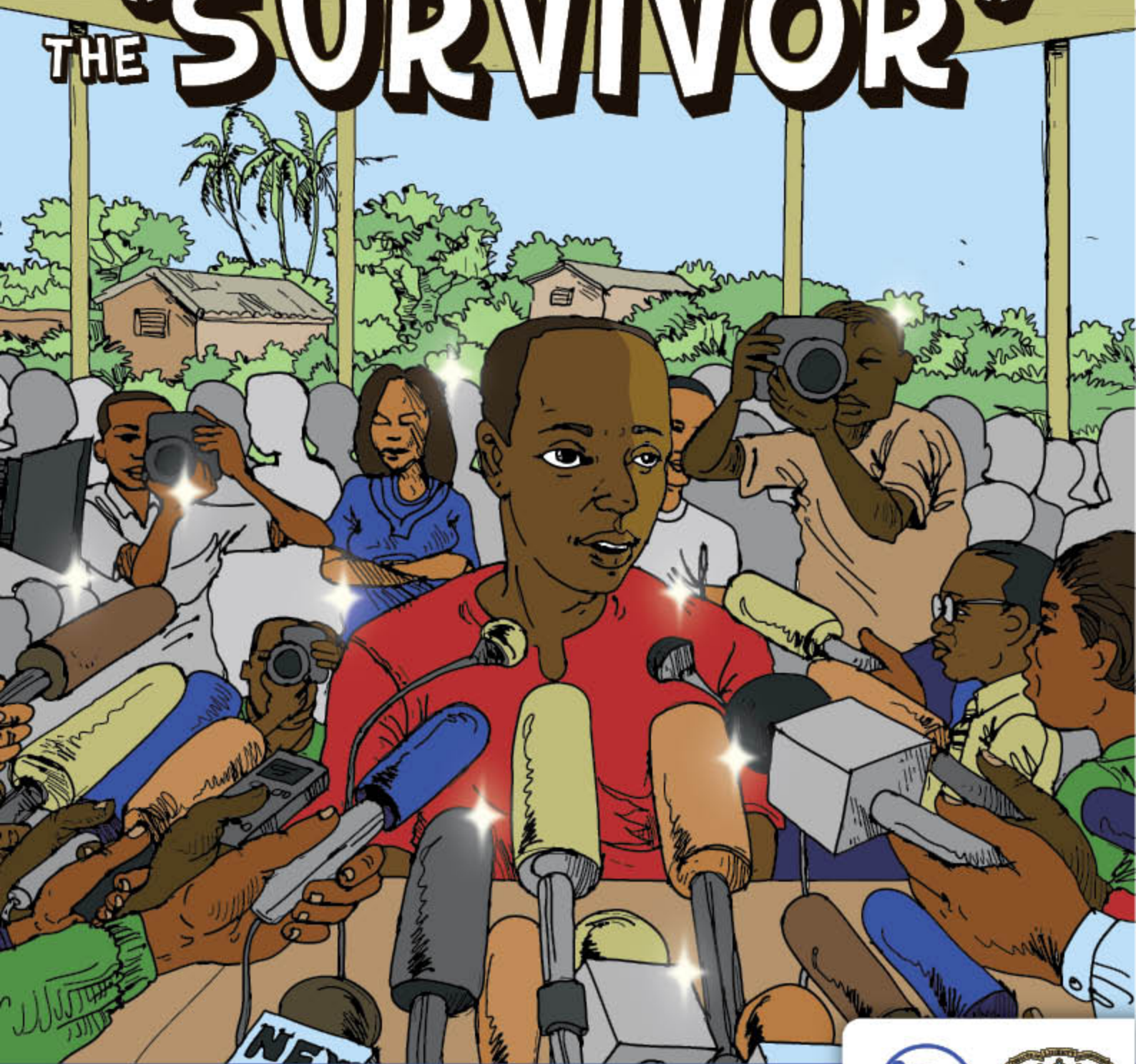

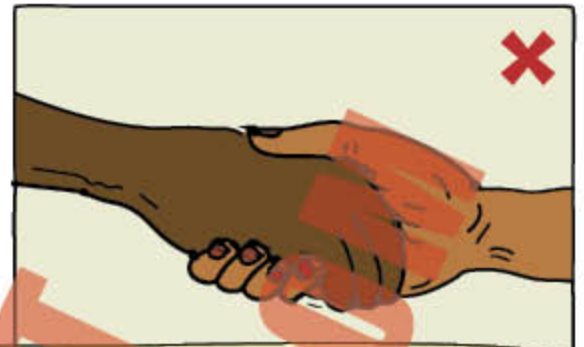
Stopping Ebola is Everybody's Business



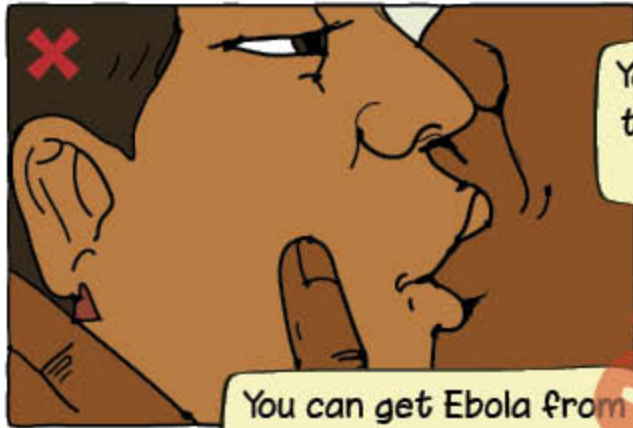




For viewers who are not familiar with Ebola, here is what we know about the virus and how it can spread.



You can get Ebola from shaking hands and touching someone who is infected.

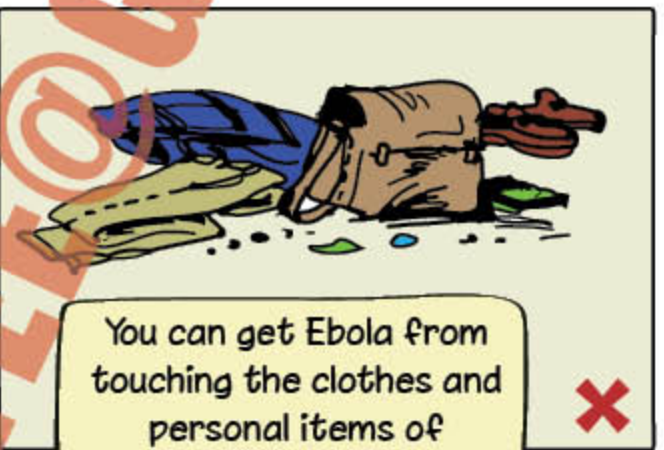


You can get Ebola from kissing and having sex.

To be honest Massa, at first I did not know how I caught Ebola! Before I got sick, I was always moving around, doing my thing. I am a very active person.



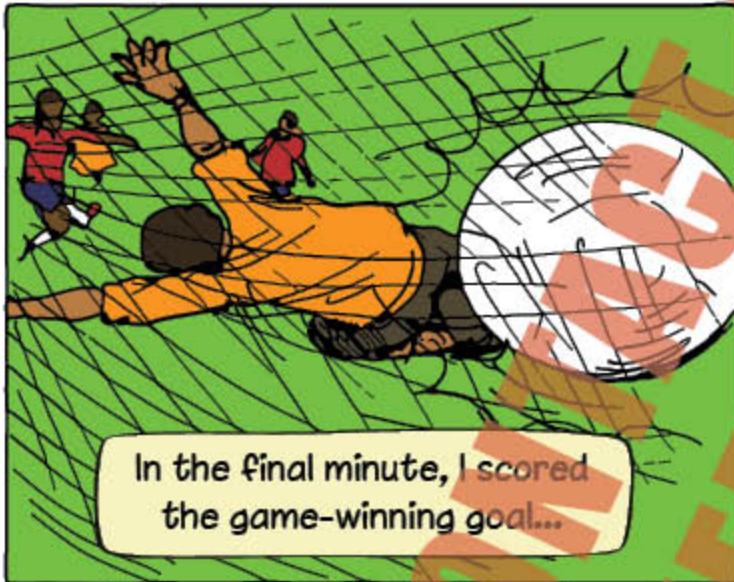
Before I got sick, I did not believe in Ebola. I thought it was not serious and that it could never catch a man like me.

We all packed into the car tight. I could have gotten Ebola there too because we were all touching, but that is not where I caught the virus!



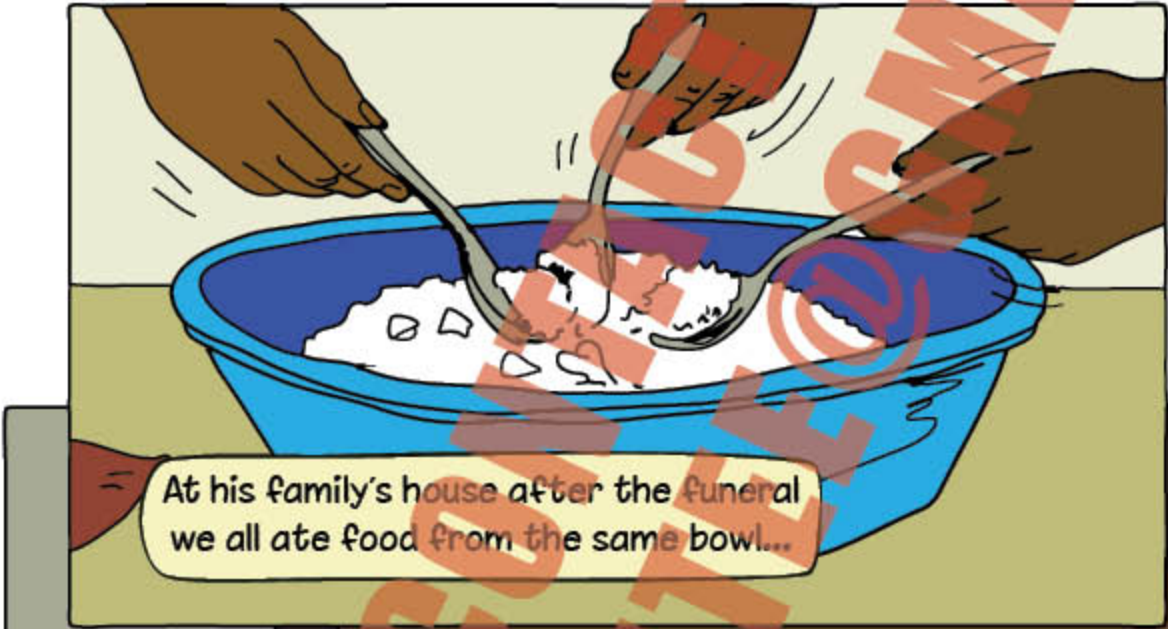
Then we went to a crowded night club. Everyone was dancing and sweating. I could have caught it there as well.

If I had known that before, I would have changed my ways. Let me tell you how I started to get sick.



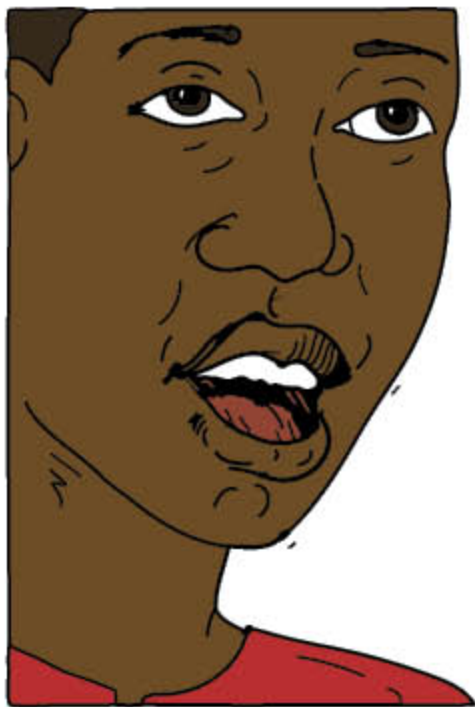
One day I started to feel weak and sweat plenty, I had a high fever and my whole body was hurting...

Soon I began to have other symptoms of Ebola. Let me tell you, it was not fun!

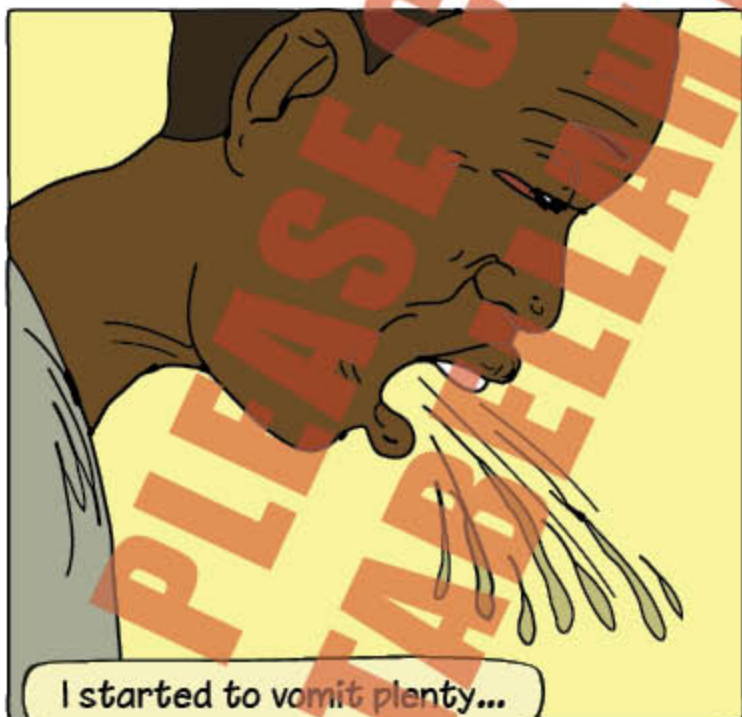
My stomach started to run...



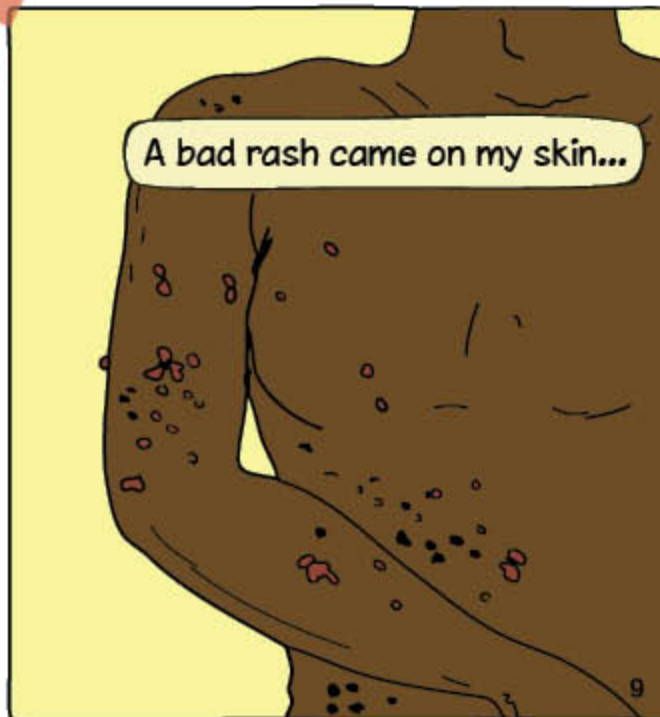
Then my eyes turn red...



I started to vomit plenty...



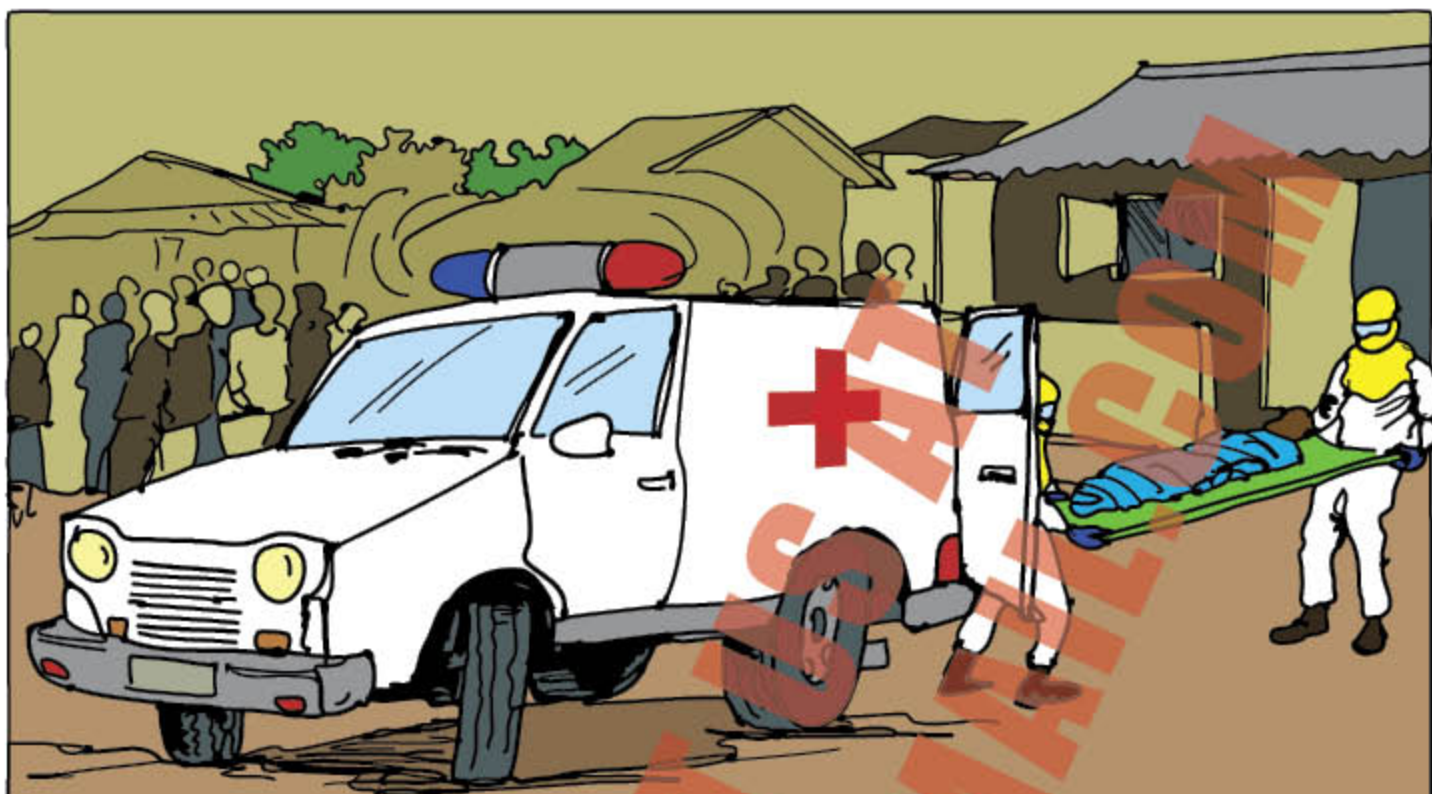
A bad rash came on my skin...

I dialed 4455 on my phone!

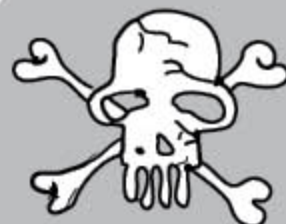
*My people, please come
