How do we ensure LARCs are seen as a youth-friendly option?



## Recommendations

Provide client-centered, contraceptive counseling that highlights effectiveness and includes the benefits of LARCs, to expand choice for all adolescent girls and young women.



Ensure health providers are able to deliver youth-friendly services through capacity-building opportunities that address provider bias, improve skills, provide support and integrate service provision.



Ensure young people can voluntarily access LARCs as part of a range of contraceptive methods, are satisfied with their method choice, and can have their method removed if and when they want to.



Develop behavior change communication messages that balance life planning with short-term decision-making, while normalizing voluntary LARCs use, accounting for young people's stage of neurocognitive development.
