





# SUMMARY

- continuum of sources used to access evidence-based social norms and social norms scale up information: formal published literature, grey literature, informal communication
- multi-layered approach to locating information, but peerreviewed literature preferred
- challenges: social norms and scale up info scattered, lacking peer-reviewed literature
- interest in short briefs, sharing tools, opportunities for knowledge and skills building, online/in-person meetings

### we wanted to know:

- 1. HOW STAKEHOLDERS SHARE EVIDENCE AND INFORMATION WITH COLLEAGUES, THE WIDER COMMUNITY
- 2. HOW THEY CURRENTLY APPLY SOCIAL NORMS/SCALE UP KNOWLEDGE IN THEIR WORK

GOAL: INFORM DISSEMINATION MECHANISMS; PRODUCE/DISSEMINATE TOPICS RELEVANT TO THE NEEDS OF THE FIELD

## common internally: emails & meetings


### common externally:

listservs, COPs, social media

### barriers:

Lack of centralized info, organizational competition

"In the field we need to be better about committing to share information.
[We]need to let go of a projects findings and share more... to allow for critical engagement."



# SUMMARY

- use email to share info with colleagues; more formal channels when disseminating to wider audience
- acknowledged the importance of disseminating in peer-reviewed literature, but challenging!
- apply information throughout program cycle
- new evidence would assist in areas of implementation, policy advocacy, proposal development

## information findings

- Stakeholders prefer peer-reviewed literature to guide their work, but there is a lack of available, centralized published literature on normative interventions and their scale up.
- Stakeholders frequently rely on the grey literature without a framework for evaluating its value.
- Need for multiple types of information dissemination for different consumption purposes and audiences
- There are many gaps in the published evidence on social norms interventions and their scale up, especially that which demonstrates its effectiveness in changing health outcomes.

## information recommendations

- Create a culture of dissemination that embraces critical discussion of the evidence.
- Create a centralized clearinghouse of information on social norms/strengthen social norms focus.
- **Tailor evidence** to different formats for different audiences and purposes.




